Objective

The produce is composed of two parts: (1) Moving the Document Release System (DRS), Change Processing Tracking and Accounting System (CPTAS) and the Enhancement/Discrepancy Systems (EDS) from the IBM 3090 to a Centerwide NT server (Data + Code) and developing a user-friendly interface (Windows look and feel). (2) Integration of the DRS, CPTAS and EDS so that they will share common data (enter once, use often).

Why Needed

The interface with the IBM 3090 is not user friendly. Many engineers will not use the system requiring continued use of data input paper. Inefficiencies exist because the engineers call the release desk to obtain information. Furthermore, the system experiences down time during peak usage periods (TADS input/certification and financial reports at the end of the month.) (2) Integration will enhance efficiency and reduce data entry. Both of which will reduce cost.
